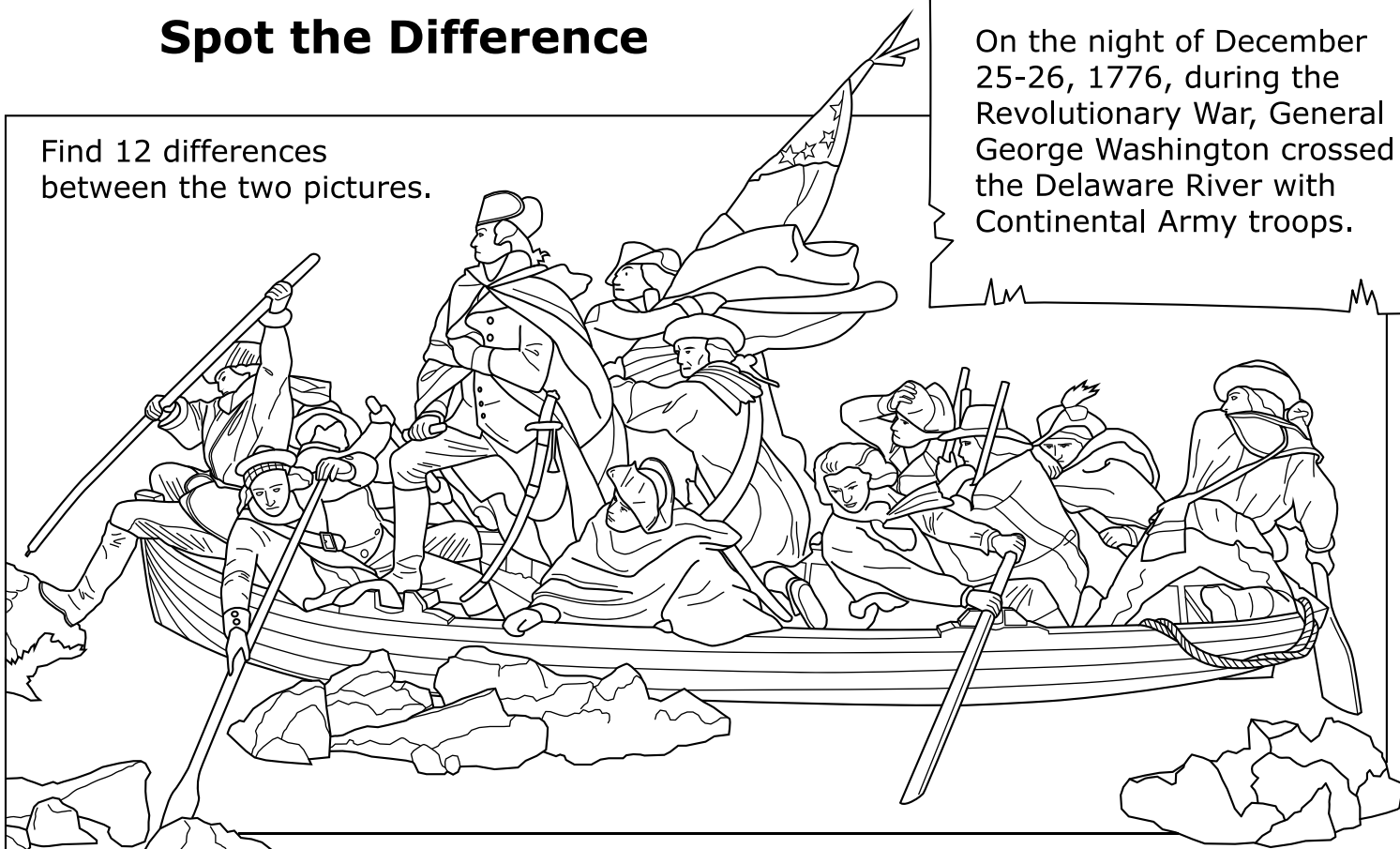


Washington Crossing the Delaware

Spot the Difference

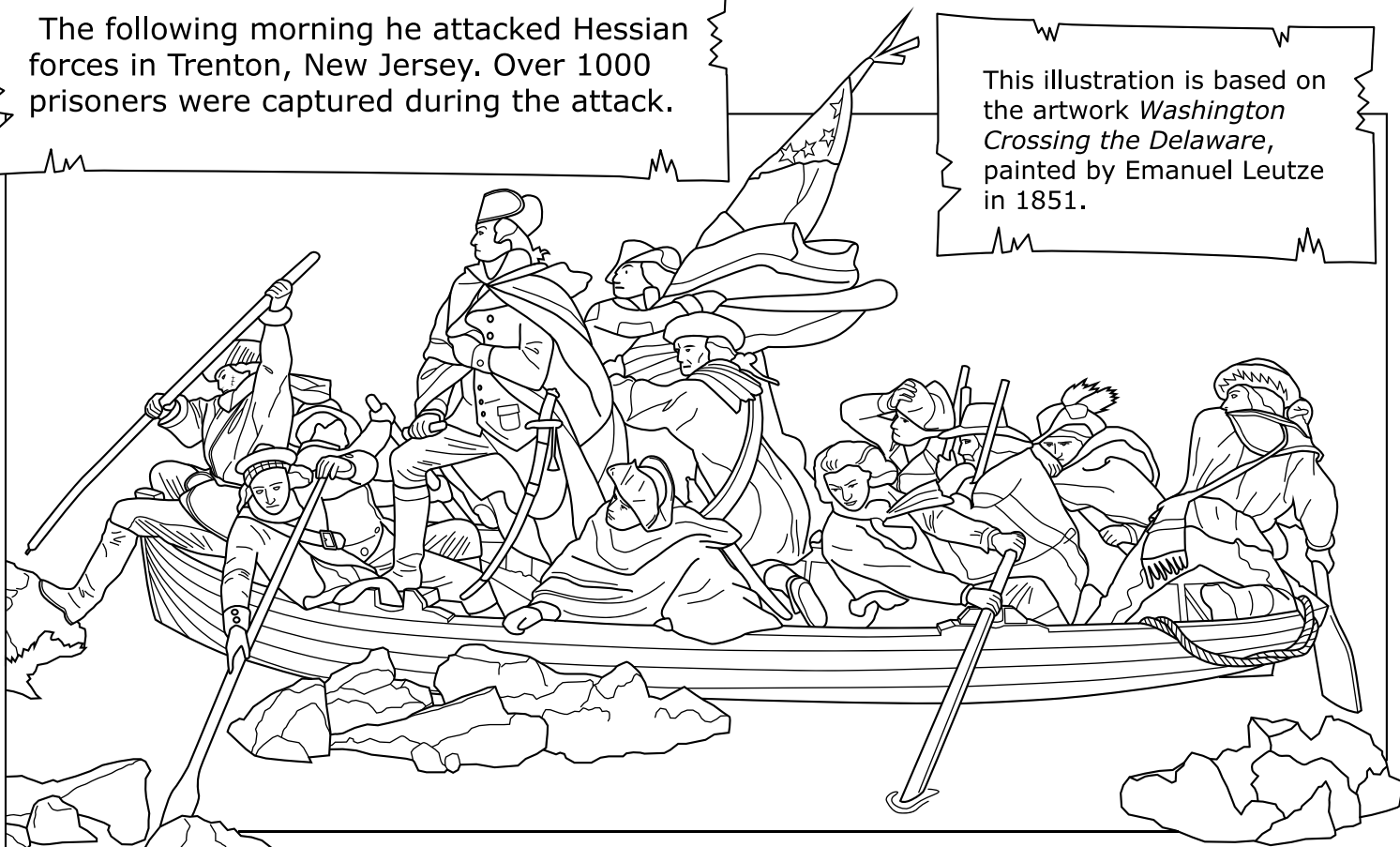
Find 12 differences between the two pictures.

This illustration is based on the artwork *Washington Crossing the Delaware*, painted by Emanuel Leutze in 1851.

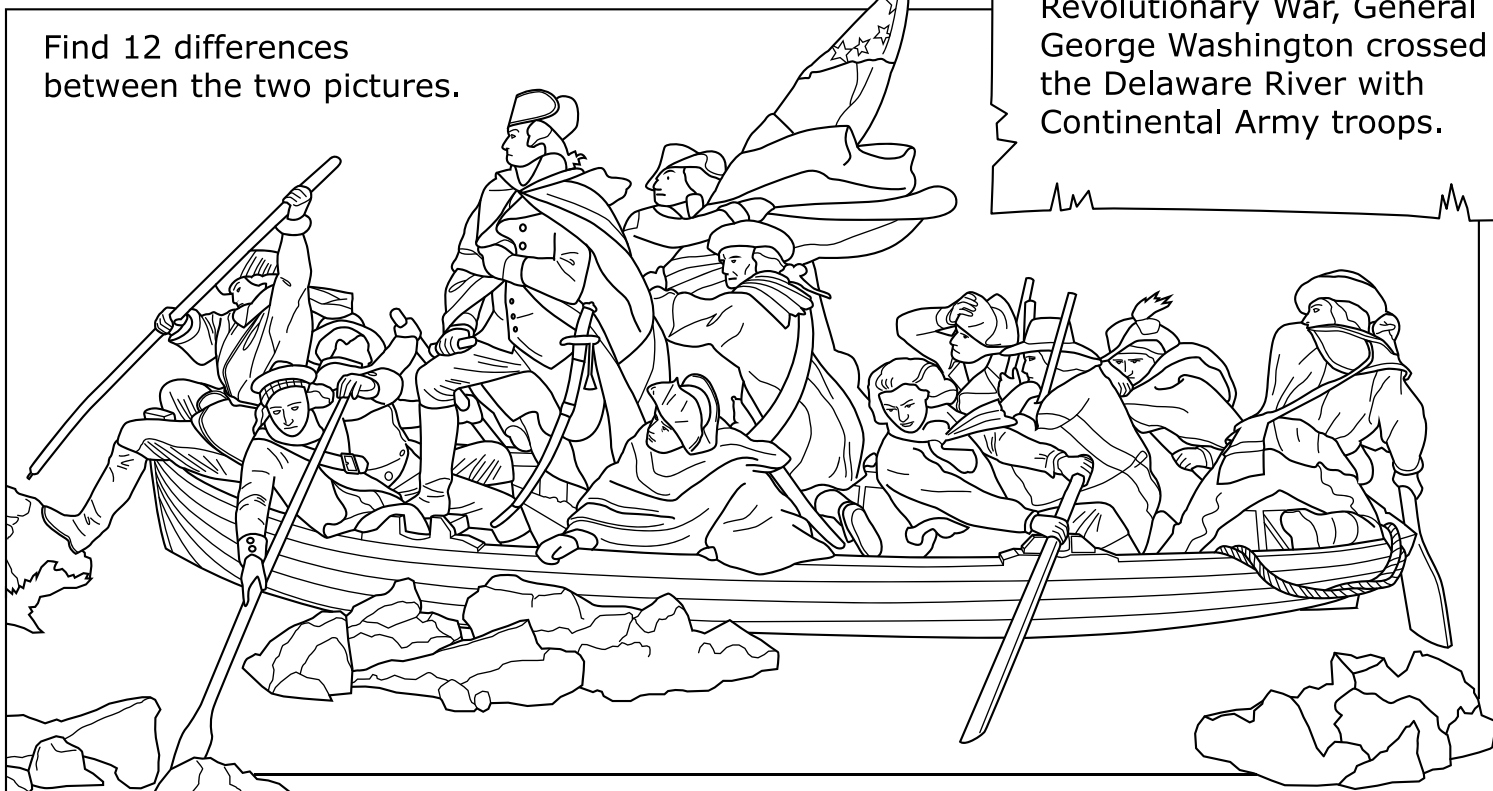
